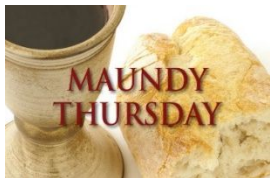

STATIONS of the CROSS

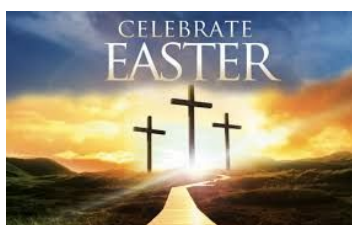
